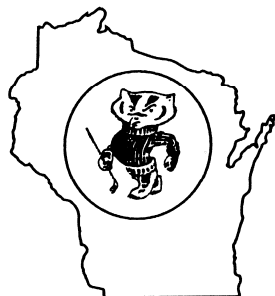

The Wisconsin Amputee Golf Association invites you to join us for the 45th Annual Badgerland Amputee Golf Outing at Coachman's Golf Resort in Stoughton Wisconsin. New this year will be a Champion Flight for golfers that wish to compete head-to-head on Sunday's round. This Flight will be playing from the BLUE TEES all weekend as well. We have joined the US Adaptive Golf Alliance (USAGA) for those that wish to have their scores recorded with the organization.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Friday, 6:00 to 8:00pm – Pick up registration information and find out hole assignments. Coachman's "pool room".

Saturday, 7:30am – We will be using a "shotgun" start. All golfers must be ready by 7:20am to hear final announcements. Please bring lawn chairs to sit around and socialize after golf. Golf carts must be returned promptly after golf.

Saturday, 6:00pm – Cocktail hour, cash bar at Coachman's banquet room.

Saturday, 7:00pm – Banquet and membership meeting at Coachman's Inn.

Sunday, 7:30am – Shotgun start! All golfers must be ready by 7:20am.

Sunday, 2:30pm – Estimated time for awards and raffle drawing. Please bring lawn chairs to sit around and socialize after golf. Golf carts must be returned promptly after golf.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Many hole prizes for both arm & leg divisions on Saturday.

Team Play: composed of five players for the two days (no handicaps).

REGISTRATION

The tournament is limited to first 80 registered golfers. Registrations received after August 1st will not be eligible for team play. Credit card payments can be accepted (with a \$5 service fee). This event is open to the following: any golfer that has a loss of, or use of limb, foot/feet or hand/hands.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Outing will be held at the beautiful Coachman's Inn Golf Resort in Stoughton, Wisconsin. The course is located just off I-90 on Hwy 51 North (Stoughton Exit 156). We have a discounted rate and room block at the motel onsite at the course. Room rates are \$89.00 plus tax per night. Pairings / Flights / Trophies:

The Champion Flight has been added for golfers in the 140-150 range for 36 holes, who have won or finished in the top five for scoring in a past Outing. **These golfers will be paired together on Sunday.**

Trophies will be awarded for Champion, Super Senior, Senior, Arm, Leg, Double & Women based on the number of golfers in that category. An average of 3-4 golfers competing for 1st & 2nd place trophies. All others will be placed in flights based on Saturday scores, with trophies given for 1st & 2nd place.

Saturday's round will be random hole assignments/pairings, while Sunday's pairings will be within a golfer's registered flight. Golfers will play from assigned tees for all 36-holes (Champion – BLUE, Women/Super Senior – RED; All others – WHITE).
